The other 12 questions are each worth 2 points


That's a max of 25 points!


If you get an answer almost right or half right, teacher will award one point instead of two points.

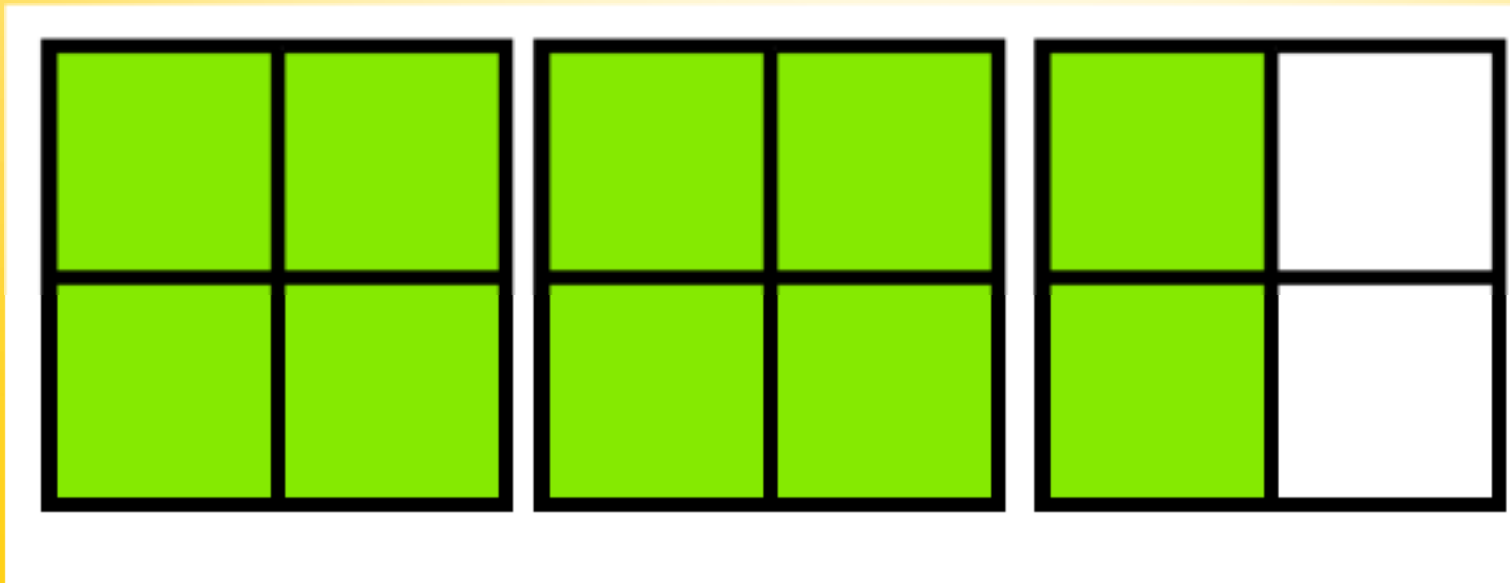
