There are 13 questions altogether. The first question is a warm-up and worth one point.


The other 12 questions are each worth 2 points

If you get an answer almost right or half right, your teacher will give you one point instead of two points.


For example, suppose the question is:

and you write “Earth and Krypton.”


Earth is right, but Krypton is not.
