
The Whizz Quiz

Rules


There are 15 questions altogether. The first question is a warm-up and worth one point.

If you get an answer almost right or half right, give yourself one point instead of two points.


For example, suppose the question is:

and you write “Red and brown.”


Red is right, but brown is not.

You would earn 1 point!
