
The Whizz Quiz

Rules


There are 13 questions altogether. The first question is a warm-up and worth one point.

The other 12 questions are each worth 2 points

That's a max of 25 points!



Your **best 4 scores** will count so keep note of your score every week and add together your best 4 scores to give you a score out of 100!



If you get an answer almost right or half right, give yourself one point instead of two points.


For example, suppose the question is:

“Name two colours of the rainbow”

and you write “Red and brown.”


Red is right, but brown is not.

You would earn 1 point!



Don't worry too much about **spelling**. If your answer is right, you'll get the points so long as your spelling is close enough.

Unless, of course, it's a spelling question!

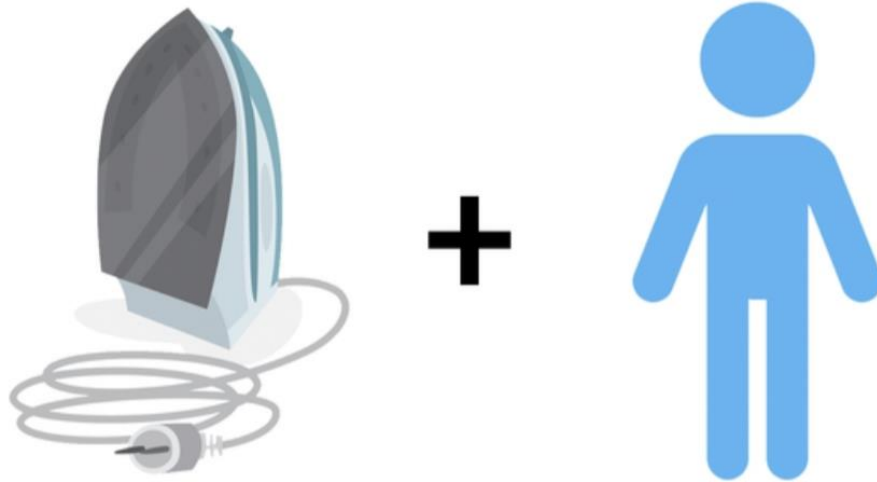

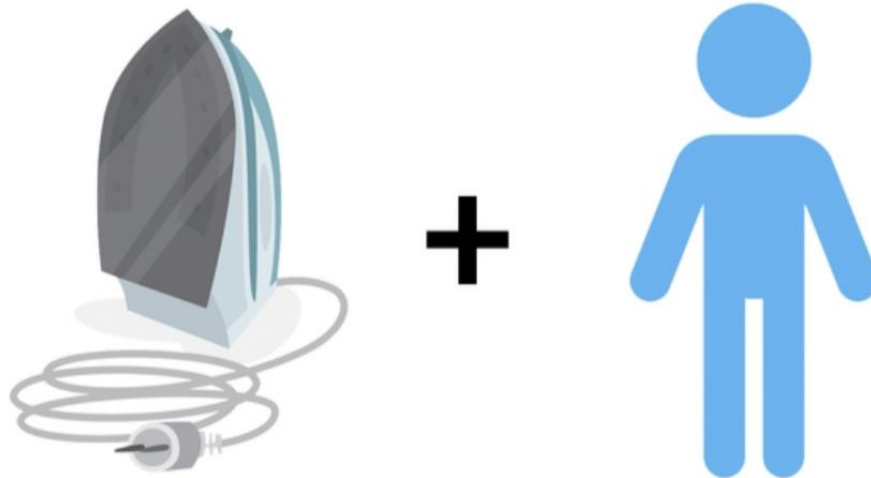
